Under the terms of the three-year agreement, Hendricks will become the exclusive healthcare provider of sports medicine services for the Corporation.

Extra-curricular sports and activities are important to our students and families. Hendricks’ services supporting the high school and middle school athletic teams will begin on April 10, 2023. There are currently two experienced athletic trainers supporting the Athenians and all will remain as part of the Hendricks team, allowing them to maintain their established relationships and offer greater continuity of care for the student-athletes. The healthcare system will also provide athletic physicals and CPR and AED instruction for high school coaches. In addition, other supportive services are available to school partners including scheduling with a certified sports dietitian.

This team includes athletic trainers, non-operative physicians, orthopedic surgeons and other healthcare providers, all with the collective goal of supporting student-athletes daily and helping them succeed in their sports or everyday activities.
